

How to Play Dots and Boxes

Materials: Pencil or pen and paper

Number of Players: 2 or more

Instructions:

Pair up.

Get a pencil or pen.

Get a piece of paper.

Draw a grid of dots, six by six, on the piece of paper.

Decide who starts. Take turns.

Draw a line between two dots.

Try to complete a box.

Don't let your adversary complete boxes.

When you complete a box, write your initial in it, then draw another line.

When all of the dots are connected, count the number of boxes. The player with the most boxes wins.

How to Play Dots and Boxes
