- 1) Read the video transcript and identify other election promises that can be expressed with *if-clauses*. Write them in the lines provided below and say them to your partner using *If I am elected...*, *If you vote for me...*, *If you elect me...*

Students may come up with the following possibilities:

- a) *If I'm elected, I'll provide a new sQuid top-up machine on the ground floor;*
- b) *If you vote for me, I'll bring the home directory back on the plato;*
- c) *If you elect me, I'll clear up the conservation area to make it a place for students to relax at lunch times or break times;*
- d) *If I'm elected, I'll revitalize and regularly update the out page your page magazine;*
- e) *If you vote for me, I'll continue the learning researchers project and expand it to include all students around the school;*
- f) *If you elect me, I'll make sure each and every one of your ideas is heard.*

- 2) The Students' Council elections are drawing near. Create your slate and think of possible election promises. Read the following tips to help your group during the process. Take notes of any ideas.
 - a) Think of possible problems your school has or the students in your school have (such as bullying, infrastructure, stereotypes, communication between teachers, students, and the school board, etc.)
 - b) Think of possible questions to ask the other slates during their election promises' presentation. They can be based on the ideas suggested in 2a.
