

You've already read the excerpt 'Weird Kids' from the book Wonder, by R.J.Palacio. Now, you and your classmate are going to discuss about some sentences from the text:

- a) The period *"Because he's a nice kid!" I always answer. "And don't call him that."* (line 4) is composed by three sentences. Identify them and the subject of each one.

1- "because he's a nice kid!" The subject is he;

2 - I always answer. the subject is I;

3 - "And don't call him that." The subject is you (os estudantes também podem falar que o sujeito está oculto, se isso ocorrer, pergunte: Can you identify the 'hidden subject'?)

- b) *"You're a saint, Summer," Ximena Chin said to me the other day.* (line 5). Explain why the narrator used the word me instead of I to refer to herself in this sentence:

The word *I* only can be used as the subject of the action/sentence.

- c) Choose which sentence below used the right substitute to the underscored word in: *"I answered her truthfully"* (line 7). After, explain your answer:

() I answered she truthfully. (x) I answered Ximena truthfully.

We think this is the right answer because **the word she can only be used as an subject.**

- d) Identify in which sentence from the text the word you has the object function. Justify your choice!

() *"You're a saint, Summer"*

(x) *"Did Mr. Tushman ask you to be friends with him?"*

We choose this sentence because **in the second sentence you comes after the verb/action**
