Grammar - Imperative

Usamos o *imperative* para **dar instruções, ordens** e para **fazer pedidos** (normalmente em conjunto com *please*) ou **proibições**. A forma do imperativo é muito simples: o verbo sem *to* no afirmativo e o verbo sem *to* precedido de *don't* no negativo. Exemplos: *Watch this!* / *Don't watch that!*
