

Atividade para impressão - Present Continuous - Review and Exercises - ING6_13UN05

O verbo **to be** é um dos mais usados na língua inglesa. Pode ser o *main verb* (verbo principal) em uma frase, como o vemos no plano **ING6_13UN02**, ou pode aparecer auxiliando o *main verb*, tornando-se assim um *auxiliary verb* (verbo auxiliar), como no tempo verbal focado nesta aula, o *Present Continuous*.

Abaixo, uma tabela básica do verbo **TO BE**

TO BE		
Affirmative	Negative	Interrogative
I am / I' m an only child.	I am not / I' m not an only child.	Am I an only child?
He is / He' s my brother.	He is not / isn't my brother.	Is he my brother?
She is / She' s my sister.	She is not / isn't my sister.	Is she my sister?
We are / We' re good friends.	We are not / aren't good friends.	Are we good friends?
They are / They' re Brazilian.	They are not / aren't Brazilian.	Are they Brazilian?
