### Present Continuous

Usamos o *present continuous* (ou *present progressive*) para descrever ações que ocorrem no momento em que falamos: *Today, I'm writing in my notebook.*

AFFIRMATIVE			NEGATIVE			INTERROGATIVE		
<i>I</i>	<b>am</b>	watching TV.	<i>I</i>	<b>am not ('m)</b>	watching TV.	<b>Am</b>	<i>I</i>	watching TV?
<i>He She It</i>	<b>is</b>		<i>He She It</i>	<b>is not (isn't)</b>		<b>Is</b>	<i>he she it</i>	
<i>We You They</i>	<b>are</b>		<i>We You They</i>	<b>are not (aren't)</b>		<b>Are</b>	<i>we you they</i>	

### Simple Present

Usamos o *simple present* para descrever ações habituais: *I usually write on my computer.*

AFFIRMATIVE	INTERROGATIVE	NEGATIVE
I/you/we/they sleep well. <i>He / She / It</i> sleeps well.	Do I / <b>you</b> / <b>we</b> / <b>they</b> sleep well? <b>Does</b> <i>he / she / it</i> sleep well?	I / you / we / they <b>don't</b> sleep well. <i>He / She / It</i> <b>doesn't</b> sleep well.
